Frank Philip Stella (May 12, 1936 - Present)

Frank Stella is a very prolific artist + has had a skillful hand in painting, print-making, sculpting, architecture + even dance. He is best known for being one of the greatest living artists + has influenced generations of American artists with his development of minimalist + maximalist styles. In his youth he attended Andover Academy, followed by Princeton University + was briefly married to the art critic, Barbara Rose, in the 1960's.

Much of his artwork is brightly colored using geometrical shapes.
